

Lions TV Bingo Application Guidelines

Bingo Season: mid October - end March – Excluding Long weekends (Holidays)

Bingo Events are held Sunday nights at 7:00 pm

Each TV Bingo is a Joint Venture between the Lions Club and Organization receiving the Donation. 40% of all ticket sales for the week will be paid to your group, 50% will be paid out in prizes and 10% will go to the Sparwood Lions for TV Bingo administration.

You will be expected to substantially assist, in selling Bingo Tickets and by playing any tickets sold by your group to anyone without Cable TV. (This has been done previously at Lilac Terrace).

The amount your group receives is increased by selling more tickets and playing tickets for anyone without Cable or access to play. Just have the buyer PRINT their name and PHONE # on the Back of their Bingo Strip.)

Sparwood Lions Club Bingo Group Selection Criteria

Any nonprofit Group or Organization which meets the Sparwood Lions Club's requirements for a Donation will be considered for a T.V. Bingo Event's Donation.

Only one Bingo Per Club or Organization will be booked per Bingo Season. If there is a shortage of applications, groups with a history of higher sales that meet the criteria will be given priority for a second Bingo.

Selection Criteria

- 1: Sparwood Based Organizations will be given preference.
- 2: The Number of Local People to Benefit from the Bingo Donation.
- 3: If two Participating Groups have had a Lions TV Bingo in Previous Years, the Club that sold the more Bingo Sheets will be given preference.
- 4: Children or Teenage Organizations.
- 5: Senior Citizen Organizations.
- 6: An Elk Valley Group (Active in Elkford, Sparwood, and Fernie Area)
- 7: Adult only Organizations.

Note:

- Organizations meeting the minimum requirements will be considered for a Bingo Event.
- Bingo Applications received by May 1st, will be considered. You will be notified by the Sept. 30, if you were successful.
- Late applications will only be considered for cancellations or Bingos still not booked at that time.
- All nonprofit Group or Organization considered for a Lion's TV Bingo will also be screened against BC Lotteries criteria.
